



Village of Orland Park ADA Sidewalk Compliance

According to Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), any alteration of a roadway that includes activities such as pavement resurfacing triggers the implementation of the **most current** ADA safety standards.

What does this mean? In some cases existing sidewalks that “empty” into the street must be eliminated. The reason for this elimination is an ADA sidewalk ramp cannot lead across the street to a location that is without an ADA-compliant ramp. In other cases, new “receiving” sidewalks will be constructed in locations where sidewalks did not previously exist to accept pedestrians from widening, and projects of similar scale and effect.
