Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by number of years living in Orland Park, presence of children 17 or under in the household, annual household income and age of respondent.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus three percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (898 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Across Community Characteristics for Mobility (such as ease of getting places, traffic flow, and ease of car travel, public transportation and walking) participants who had lived in Orland Park less than 10 years, had kids or made more than \$100,000 per year tended to give lower ratings for Mobility while participants 55 and older tended to give higher ratings. Mobility ratings in the pillars of Governance and Participation varied among groups. All groups had differences in ratings for traffic flow and carpooling.
- Those without kids or 55 or older gave higher ratings for the overall natural environment. While participants who had lived in Orland Park more than 20 years and those who made over \$100,000 per year rated recycling and yard-waste removal highly. Those who lived in Orland Park more than 20 years or were 55 and older also gave higher ratings for drinking water quality and were more likely to have recycled in the past 12 months.
- Community Characteristic ratings for Economy tended to be higher for those who made less than \$49,999 or
 were 55 years or older. However, those who had lived in Orland Park for more than 10 years or were 18-34
 years old gave higher ratings for economic development and had more optimism that the economy would have
 a positive impact on their income.
